

LMCCI - Verifica conoscenze in ingresso per la lingua inglese

Il colloquio mira a verificare le competenze in inglese di livello C1.

The focus is on organizing large units of discourse, comparing, describing, expressing opinions and speculating. The examiner will also evaluate the correctness of grammar structures, the adequacy of pronunciation, and the appropriateness of vocabulary.

Each candidate may be presented with prompts such as texts, newspaper articles, or pictures and asked to comment on and react to them. You may be asked to compare and contrast, speculate and express viewpoints about your personal experiences or current affairs. You will have the opportunity to demonstrate your ability to organise your thoughts and ideas. In addition, you may be asked to comment on specific grammar structures or linguistic functions.

Candidates may also be asked to translate a short passage from Italian into English and vice-versa.

Example:

- In your opinion, what is the role of English as a global language?
- Please read and give your opinion about this short article:

BBC takes a close-up look at new Banksy London mural

Crowds have gathered to take photographs - and take in - a new tree mural in north London after street artist Banksy claimed the piece on Monday.

The mural - a mass of green paint sprayed on a wall behind a cut-back tree to look like foliage, with a stencil of a person holding a pressure hose next to it - appeared on Sunday.

It was speculated that Banksy was behind the piece as soon as it appeared, and the street artist confirmed it was his by uploading before and after pictures of the Finsbury Park mural to social media.
